<p>Fruit peel/cores/old fruit/vegetables</p> <p>Bread, cakes and pastries</p> <p>Tea bags/coffee filters/coffee grounds</p> <p>Fish/shellfish</p> <p>Meat remnants/small bones</p> <p>Eggshell/nutshell</p> <p>Used kitchen paper</p> <p>Empty rolls from kitchen and toilet paper/egg trays</p> <p>Houseplant (without the flowerpot)</p> <p>Do not dispose of packaging material in the food waste container.</p>	<p>Newspaper/copy paper/envelopes</p> <p>Advertising leaflets/weeklies/journals/magazines</p> <p>Milk/juice cartons</p> <p>Pizza/cereal/yoghurt - etc. cartons</p> <p>Packaging cartons/cardboard trays</p> <p>Softcover books</p> <p>Do not use plastic bags for paper waste. Waste goes directly into the container.</p>	<p>Dog litter bags/baby nappies/sanitary pads</p> <p>Vacuum cleaner bags</p> <p>Cooled ashes/coal/cigarette butts/snuff</p> <p>Candles</p> <p>Soiled plastic and paper/wrapping paper</p> <p>Styrofoam</p> <p>Plastic bags from coffee/snacks/chips/gravy with aluminium foil inside</p> <p>Electronic waste and batteries should be delivered at our recycle stations.</p>	<p>Plastic bags</p> <p>Plastic cans/plastic cups and boxes</p> <p>Clean plastic wrapping from meat, poultry, fish, fruit, berries, vegetables and cold cuts</p> <p>Plastic bottles for detergents/shampoo/dressings</p> <p>Plastic flower pots</p> <p>Toothpaste tubes and other plastic tubes</p> <p>Tomme snusbokser</p> <p>Rinse the plastic in cold water, if required. Plastic that is not packaging, like garden hose, plastic chairs etc. should be delivered as remaining waste</p>	<p>Aluminium foil/packaging</p> <p>Bottles and glass packaging</p> <p>Tin cans</p> <p>Metal lids/screw caps</p> <p>Non-recyclable beer/soda water cans</p> <p>Metal tubes</p> <p>Tea candle metal cups</p> <p>Light bulbs and fluorescent lamps should be delivered at our recycling stations</p>	<p>Clothes/shoes</p> <p>Caps/scarves/mittens/gloves</p> <p>Towels/bed linen</p> <p>Curtains/tablecloths</p> <p>Handbags/purses</p> <p>Stuffed animals</p> <p>The materials can be used, but they must be clean, intact and dry before being delivered.</p> <p>To protect the fabric until sorted, please deliver in a closed plastic bag.</p>	<p>Grass/weed</p> <p>Leaves</p> <p>Twigs/branches</p> <p>Potted plants/flowers</p> <p>Do not put garden waste in the food container.</p> <p>Black-listed plants are remaining waste.</p> <p>Read more about black-listed plants at <a href="http://naturvernforbundet.no">naturvernforbundet.no</a></p> <p>Separate area for garden waste. Attention! Cannot be delivered at Bodø recycling station (Bodøelv)</p>	<p>Electronic toys/LED-shoes</p> <p>Mobile phones/computer equipment/watches</p> <p>Electric razors and hair dryers</p> <p>Domestic appliances</p> <p>Radio/TV</p> <p>Vacuum cleaners</p> <p>Lamps</p> <p>Electric tools/cords/wires and cables</p> <p>At Bodøelv recycling station we only accept small electronic waste. Items larger than a microwave must be delivered at one of the other stations</p>	<p>Impregnated wood</p> <p>Paint/stain/white spirit</p> <p>Glue</p> <p>Chemicals/waste oil</p> <p>Batteries</p> <p>Energy-efficient light bulbs/light bulbs/fluorescent lamps</p> <p>Asbestos/eternit</p> <p>PCB/Chloroparaffin windows</p> <p>Spray cans/caulk foam</p> <p>It is preferred for hazardous waste to be delivered in its original packaging</p>	<p>Building materials and woodwork</p> <p>Iron and metals</p> <p>Porcelain/ceramic tiles/glass/concrete/gravel and stone/rocks</p> <p>DOMESTIC CUSTOMERS CAN ALSO DELIVER AT OUR RECYCLING STATIONS:</p> <p>Cardboard/paper</p> <p>Domestic plastic</p> <p>Glass/metal packaging</p> <p>Other waste is to be thrown away as remaining waste.</p> <p>Remaining waste is what is left after recycling</p>
<p>Brown container for food waste</p>	<p>Blue container for cardboard, paper and carton</p>	<p>Black container for remaining waste</p>	<p>Domestic plastic packaging is to be put in the designated bag from Iris Salten</p>	<p>Green container for glass/metal packaging</p>	<p>To be delivered at our recycling stations</p>	<p>Separate area for garden waste. Attention!
